30-Year History

This tab shows 30 years of Cook County property tax increases, in both real dollars and in inflation-adjusted dollars.

- It shows that the countywide property tax total grew faster than inflation — exceeding it by 48% during the past 30 years.
- To see how taxes grew over that period just in Chicago, in the North and Northwest suburbs or in the South and Southwest suburbs, click the tabs in the upper right corner (outlined in the blue box).

TIP: To view a wider frame of the graphic, click the sideways "v" in the upper right corner of the screen (outlined in green circle).




Total Increase

This tab shows how much countywide taxes increased from tax year 2022 to 2023.

 To see the increase for all properties; combined business and residential; or broken down by commercial, residential, industrial, multifamily and vacant land, click on the tabs in the lower right corner (blue box).



Region Changes

This tab shows the changes in total amounts billed in each assessment region (Chicago, north and northwest suburbs, and south and southwest suburbs) from tax year 2023 to 2024.


 To break down the changes by all properties, commercial vs. residential and by detailed property class, click on the tabs in the upper right corner (blue box).



Tax Levies

This tab shows the amount of taxes sought be each taxing agency in Cook County.


- This data is displayed in sets by the type of tax agency — county, municipal, school district and the like — and compares "extensions," which are the certified levies, in 2024 to 2023.
- Use the drop-down boxes at the right to filter this data by tax agency type and name (blue box).



Assessment Values

Click this tab to see the median and total assessed value increases in each suburb, Chicago community area and Chicago ward.

- Toggle between the rectangles in the upper right corner to see this data for Chicago and the two suburban regions. (blue box).
- To sort by municipality, county region and Chicago ward, use the "View Type" dropdown menu (green box).
- To sort by property type, click on the circles at the lower right (purple box).




Tax Bill Details

This tab shows the median and total bill changes increases and decreases.

 Like the other tabs, this one can be sorted by Chicago and the two suburban regions; broken down by municipality, county region and ward.

TIP: To sort by assessment region (blue rectangle); highest to lowest, or lowest to highest (green rectangle), click the header tab at the top, then hover over it to see those options.



TIF Changes

This tab shows the increases from 2023 to 2024 in the amounts billed for tax increment finance districts in each of the three assessment regions.

 Click the headings at the top of the bar chart to view only one region or eliminate it from the chart. You can also reverse the order of the years (blue rectangle).

TIP: To undo any changes you made by clicking the headings, or reset to the original view, use the curved arrows (green rectangle) at the bottom of the Tableau display. To view the chart in full screen, click the box symbol (purple box).



TIF Districts

This tab shows the how much each tax increment finance district in Cook County billed in 2023 and 2024, as well as the difference between those amounts.

- To search for all the TIF
 districts in a single city or
 village, use the dropdown
 "Municipality" tab to select the
 city or village you are interested
 in (blue rectangle).
- You can also break it down by assessment region to see overall trends in each region (green box).
